




THE ROLE A COSTUME PLAYS IN TELLING A STORY




COSTUMES HELP ESTABLISH TIME AND PLACE – WEATHER IT ELIZABETHIAN, THE 1050'S OR FUTURISTIC. THIS IS DONE THROUGH THE USE OF LINES, COLORS AND SILHOUETTES, ALSO BY USING ICON LOOKS OF THE TIME PERIOD







INDICATE THE NATURE OF CHARACTERS, PERSONALITY, OCCUPATION, ETC. (uniform)



THEY CAN HELP SHOW RELATIONSHIP AMONG CHARACTERS. HELP SEPARATE MAJOR AND MINOR CHARACTERS, SEPARATE GROUPS OF CHARACTERS. (I.E. WEST SIDE STORY)




SYMBOLICALLY CONVEY THE SIGNIFICANCE OF CERTAIN CHARACTERS DEATH


MEET THE NEEDS OF PEFORMERS:

COSTUMES NEED TO ADEQUATELY SUIT THE TYPE OF WORK THEY HAVE TO DO IN A SHOW. (LOOSE MOVE FREELY, TUMBLING, TIGHT AND FLEXIBLE)
BE CONSISTENT WITH THE PRODUCTION AS A WHOLE. AS WITH ALL ELEMENTS,
COSTUMES NEED TO FIT IN WITH OVERALL COHESIVE PICTURE. (THE COSTUMES,
FLOOR, FLAGS, MUSIC ALL NEED TO BE IN THE SAME WORLD / THE SAME COHESIVE
THOUGHT



DEPENDS ON SHOW, IS IT CHARACTER DRIVEN, WILL HAVING A COSTUME ON HELP TELL THE STORY? IS IT ABSTRACT? IS IT ABOUT COLOR OR SPIRIT OF THE PIECE MOVING?

ALSO, IF A BUDGET IS AN ISSUE, SOMETHING SIMPLE AND UNIFORM COULD BE BEST



MAKE SURE THEY BELONG TOGETHER, THAT IT IS ONE COHESIVE THOUGHT IF THE FLOOR IS BUSY KEEP THE COSTUME SIMPLE AND VISA VERSA



FLAGS: IMAGES AND SUBJECTS ON FLAGS CAN BE GREAT, BUT OFTEN TIMES THEY ARE UNSEEN IF YOU ARE NOT SPINNING SLOWLY, THEY NEED TO BE INTRODUCED SLOWLY. AGAIN, IF WE ARE HAVING BUSY FLAGS, YOU MAY WANT A SIMPLER FLOOR AND COSTUME



RED: POWER/STRENGH

BLUE: PEACEFUL/CELESTIAL/CALM

YELLOW: CHEERFUL/BRIGHT PURPLE: ROYAL/PASSIONATE



COLORS REFLECT THE FEELING OR EMOTION OF A PIECE
AGAIN, COLOR PALATTE CAN HELP SEPARATE GROUPS WITHIN A PIECE
TEXTURES OF FABRICS CAN CREATE A SMOOTHNESS OR A ROUGHNESS FOR A THE
PIECE — YOU CAN ALSO PRINT A TEXTURE ON LYCRA
FABRIC IS USEFUL FOR ALSO CREATING MOVEMENT
POLYESTERS ARE EASIEST FOR UPKEEP AND CLEANING
LYCRA HAS A SHINY AND DULL SIDE WHICH YOU CAN USE EITHER
FOR SKIRTS (POLY GEORGETTE OR POLY CHIFFON)
YOU CAN MIX IN SOME PURCHASED COSTUMES/PIECES FOR EFFECT




IT IS IMPORTANT THAT IF YOU HAVE A YOUNGER GUARD THAT YOU ARE NOT DOING A PIECE THAT THE COSTUME IS ONE OF BURLESQUE OR SCANTILY CLAD KEEP THINGS MORE WHOLESOME AND DEMURE FOR YOUNGER GROUPS



LARGER GIRLS: DARKER COLORS, HIGHER WAISTLINES, JUST BECAUSE THE GUARD IS IN ALL THE SAME COLOR DOESN'T MEAN EVERYONE HAS TO BE IN THE EXACT SAME OUTFIT




LESS EXPERIENCED GUARDS MAY WANT TO BE UNIFORMED (ALL THE SAME) THIS HELPS WITH GROUP SOLIDARITY AND KEEPS THE EYE WIDE INSTEAD OF FOCUSING IN ON ONE MEMBER



DON'T GET CAUGHT UP COPY OTHER GUARDS

IF A PERFORMANCE THAT YOU REMEMBER IS MAKING YOU WANT TO COPY IT, CHANCES ARE JUDGES WILL REMEMBER THE ORIGINAL PERFORMANCE AS WELL AND KNOW THAT YOU HAVE COPIED THE PIECE

SPEND SOME TIME THINKING ABOUT WHAT COULD BE INTERESTING AND DIFFERENT FOR YOUR SITUATION AND EXPERIENCE, IF YOU NORMALLY CHOOSE A CERTAIN COLOR OR SILHOUETTE, THINK ABOUT GOING AGAINST YOUR "TYPE" AND MOVE OUT OF YOUR COMFORT ZONE. COMMIT TO THE STORY OR EXPERIENCE YOU ARE TRYING TO TELL AND FIND WAYS TO CONVEY IT.



SOMETIMES THE JUDGES AND AUDIENCE HAVE A HARD TIME GRASPING A LOT OF COLORS ,IT BECOME "VISUALLY NOISY

IF YOU HAVE VOLUNTEERS USE THEM, MOST PEOPLE KNOW SOMEONE WHO CAN SEW (MOST LIKELY ONE OF THE GUARDS PARENTS)

ONLINE PROM DECORATION SHOPS HAVE A LOT OF CHEAP IDEAS
IF YOU NEED A BASE, MOST UNIFORM COMPANIES HAVE THE BASICS TO GET
STARTED

SHOES OR BAREFEET – TREADS CAN BE TOUGH TO MOVE ON THE FLOOR –
BAREFEET IS A SOLID OPTIONS ALSO, THERE ARE ALSO DANCE SANDLES WITH COVER
JUST THE BALL OF THE FOOT AND HELP WITH TRACTION

THINK ABOUT HAIR AND MAKE-UP- IF YOUR GOING TO GO ALL THE WAY – DON'T SELL YOURSELF SHORT. HAIR AND MAKE-UP CAN REALLY BE A GREAT TOOL TO TELL THE STORY – NOT EVERYONE NEEDS TO LOOK LIKE A CHEERLEDER – SHOOT FOR REALISM IF THAT IS WHAT IS RIGHT.

IF YOUR NOT SURE, ASK FOR HELP FROM SOMEONE. WHEN IN DOUBT, KEEP IT SIMPLE!



PLEASE HAVE FUN. I AM NON INVESTED VISTOR TO THE ACTIVITY AND I AM MOVED BY THE COLORS, THE MUSIC, THE VISUAL AND MOST IMPORTANTLY THE PASSION THAT IS INSTILLED BY INSTRUCTORS AND THE STAFF. IF YOU HAVE IT YOU WILL NATURALLY GIVE IT TO YOUR GUARD.
