NJNJ is once again pleased to announce this scholarship opportunity. Any performer of a unit in good standing with MAIN can apply.

The recipient will be chosen by the NJNJ Scholarship Committee which is comprised of NJNJ Executive Board Members. The scholarship recipient will be announced at the MAIN Championship show.

All unit directors are invited to select one participant and apply for this scholarship based on the following criteria.

Criteria:

1. The applicant must be an active 2022 marching member of a unit in MAIN.
2. The performer is furthering their education at a trade school, community college, university or is extending their performing experience as a member of a Drum Corps for summer 2022.

Application Process:

1. The director should submit the applicant's essay no later than April 4, 2022 to:

2. The director should provide the performers personal information which includes name, address, age, the name of the trade school, college, university or Drum Corps.
3. Unit name and Class
4. Head shot in or out of costume.

Essay:

The essay must be a minimum of 2 full pages, maximum of 4 pages. The essay should be typed using a 12pt font using paragraphs with double spacing. The essay should pertain to color guard as it relate to one of the following themes:

- Overcoming Challenges
- Inclusion/Acceptance
- Resilience
- Leadership
